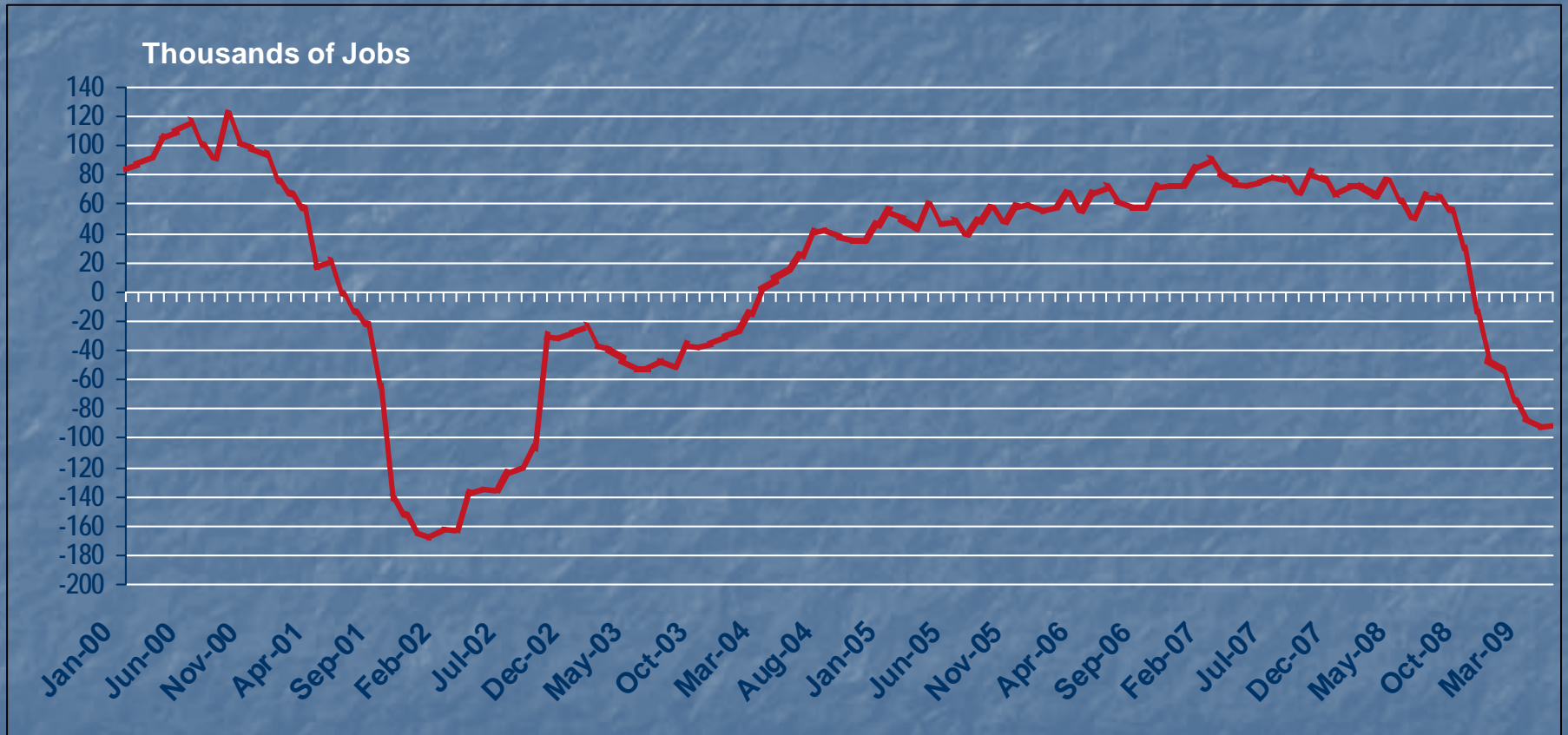
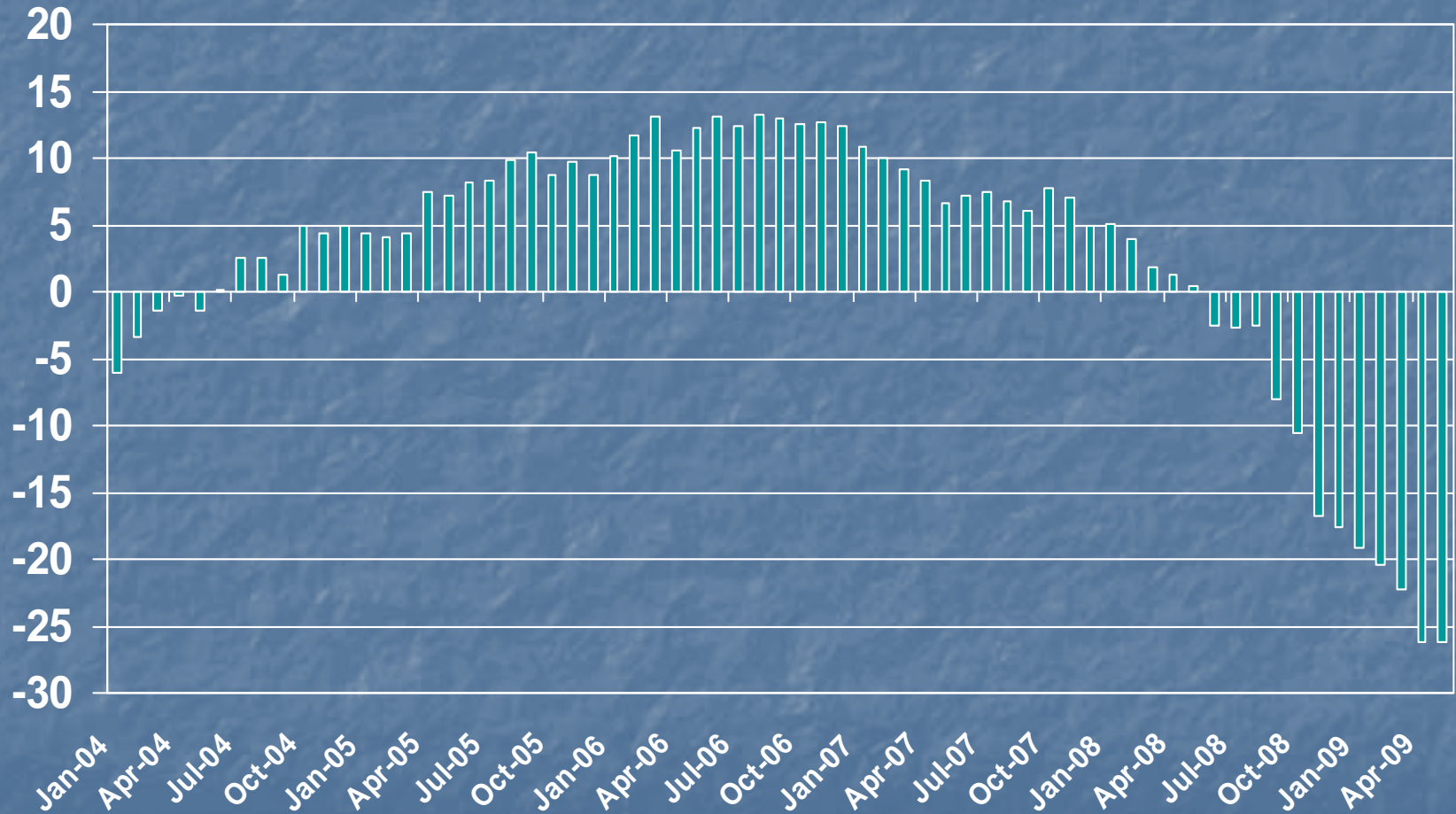


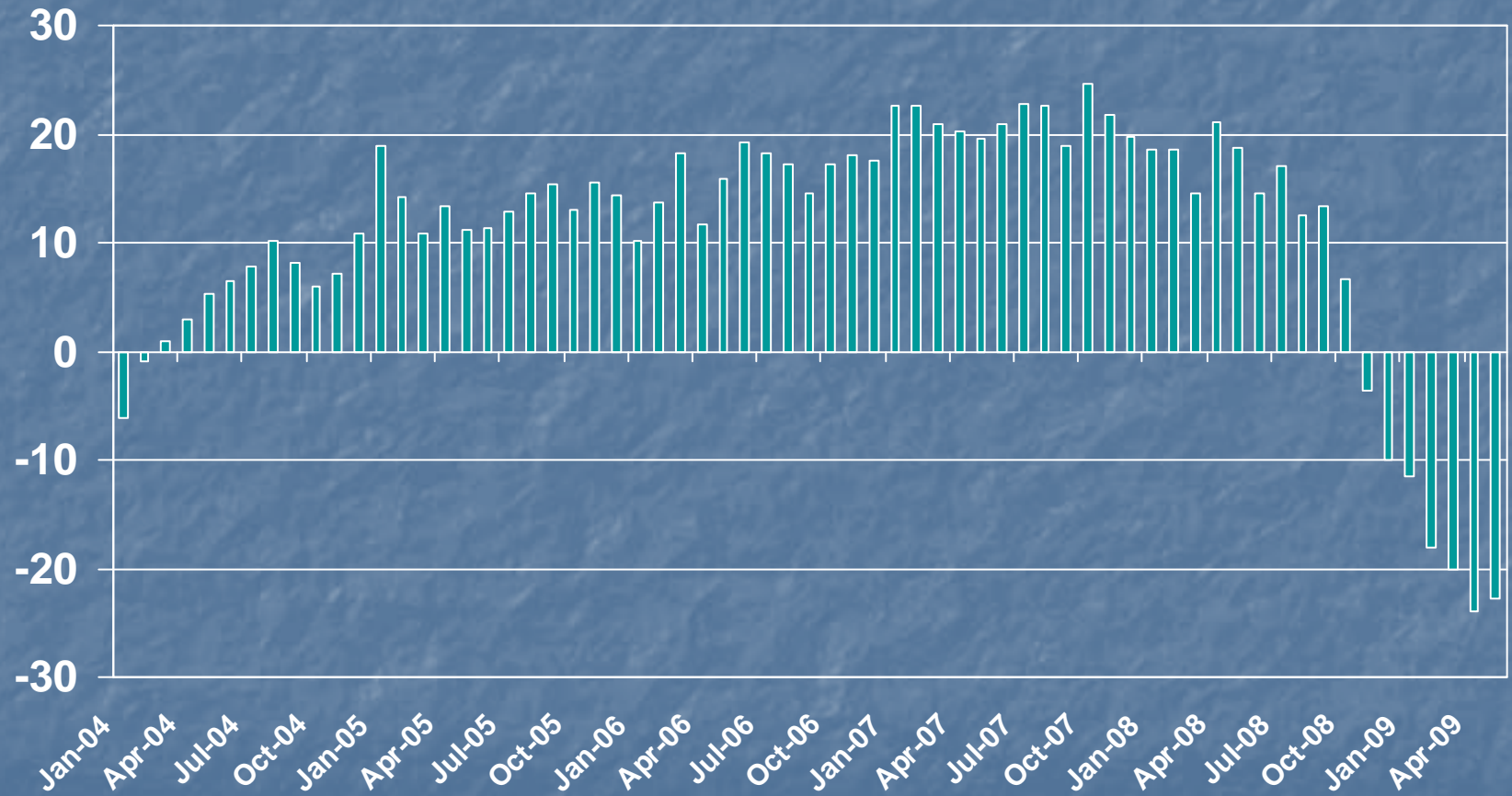

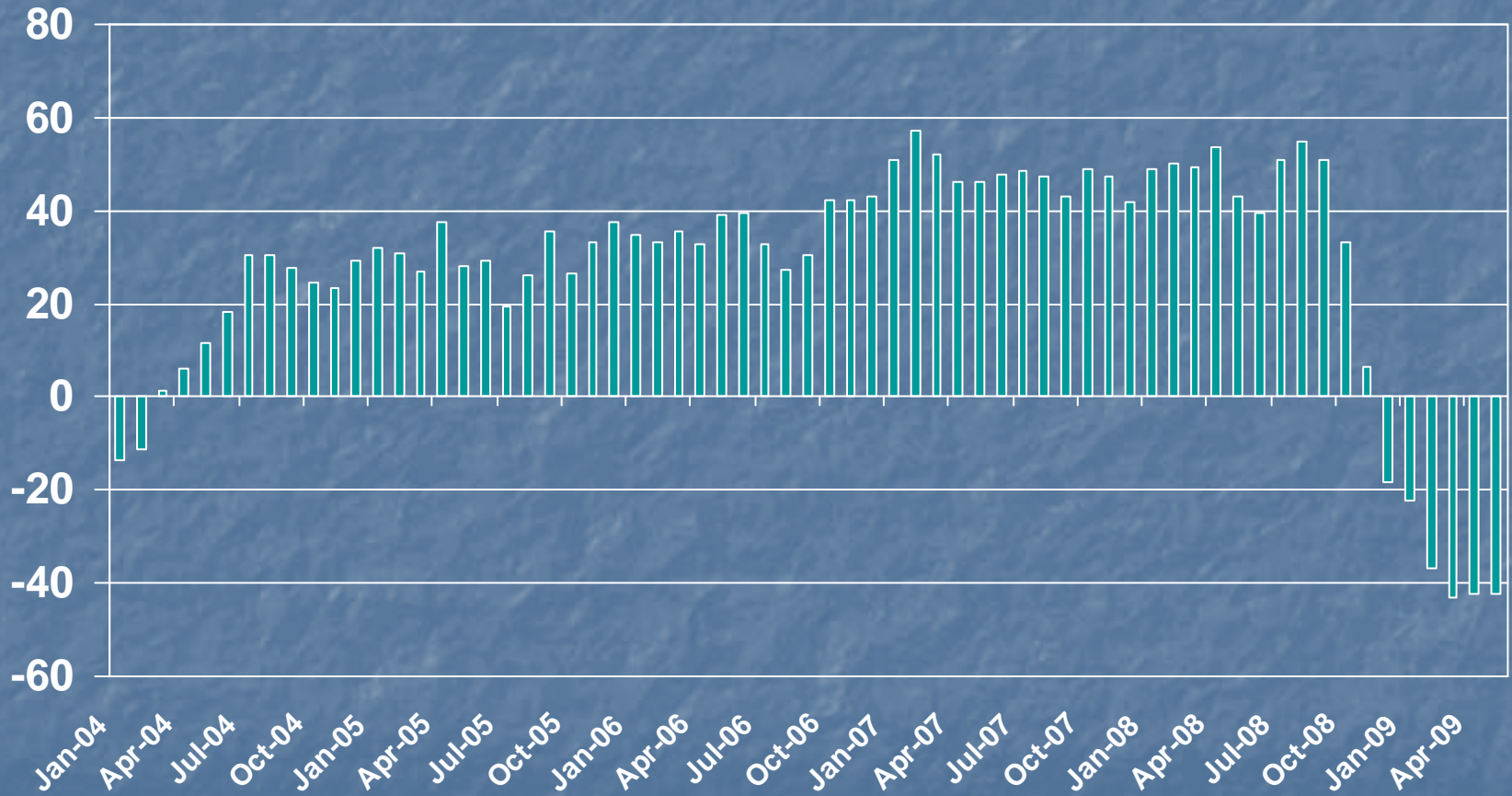
Over-The-Year Change in Finance & Insurance Jobs



Over-The-Year Change in Professional & Business Services Jobs

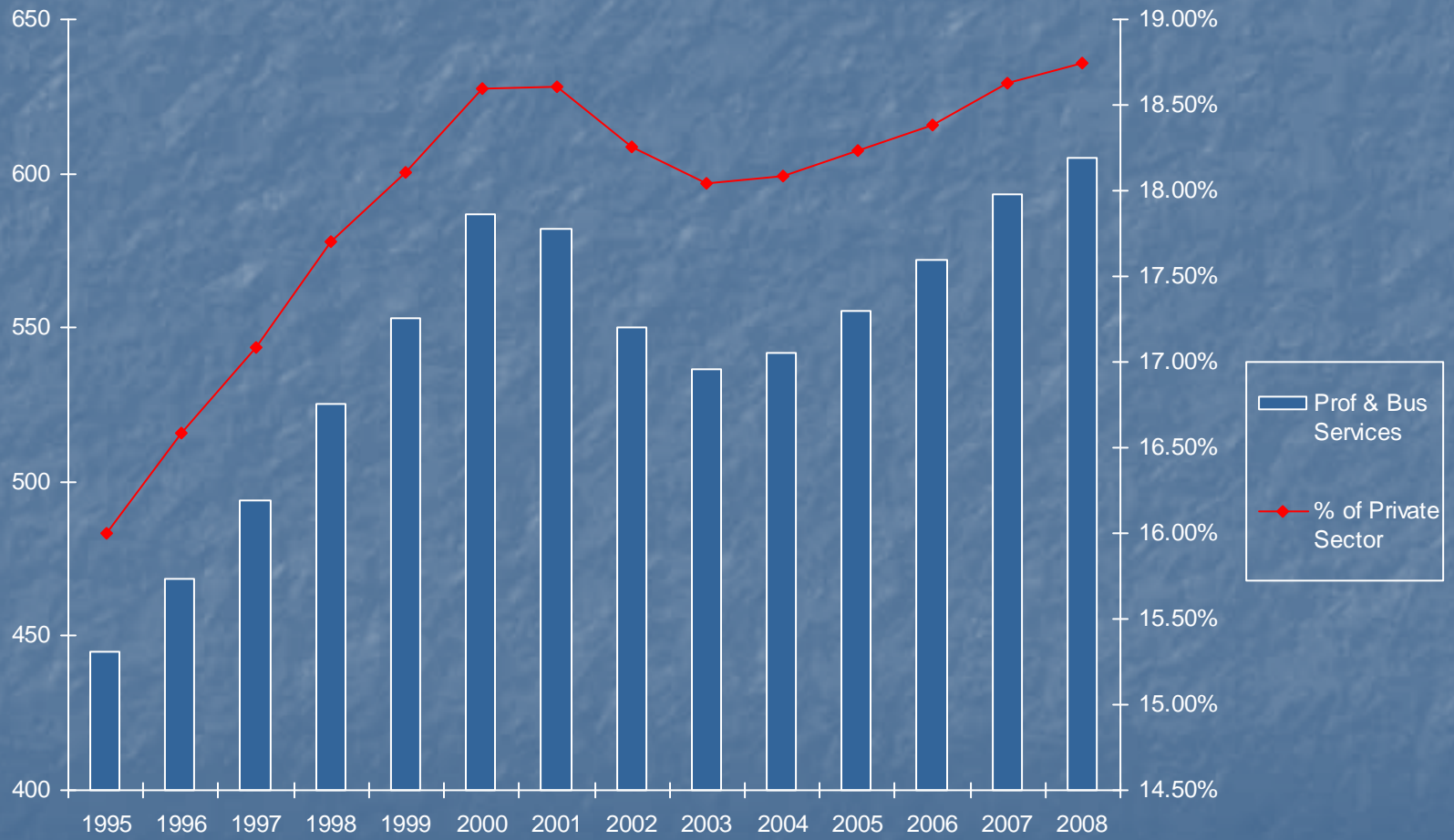


Over-The-Year Change in All Other Private Sector Jobs



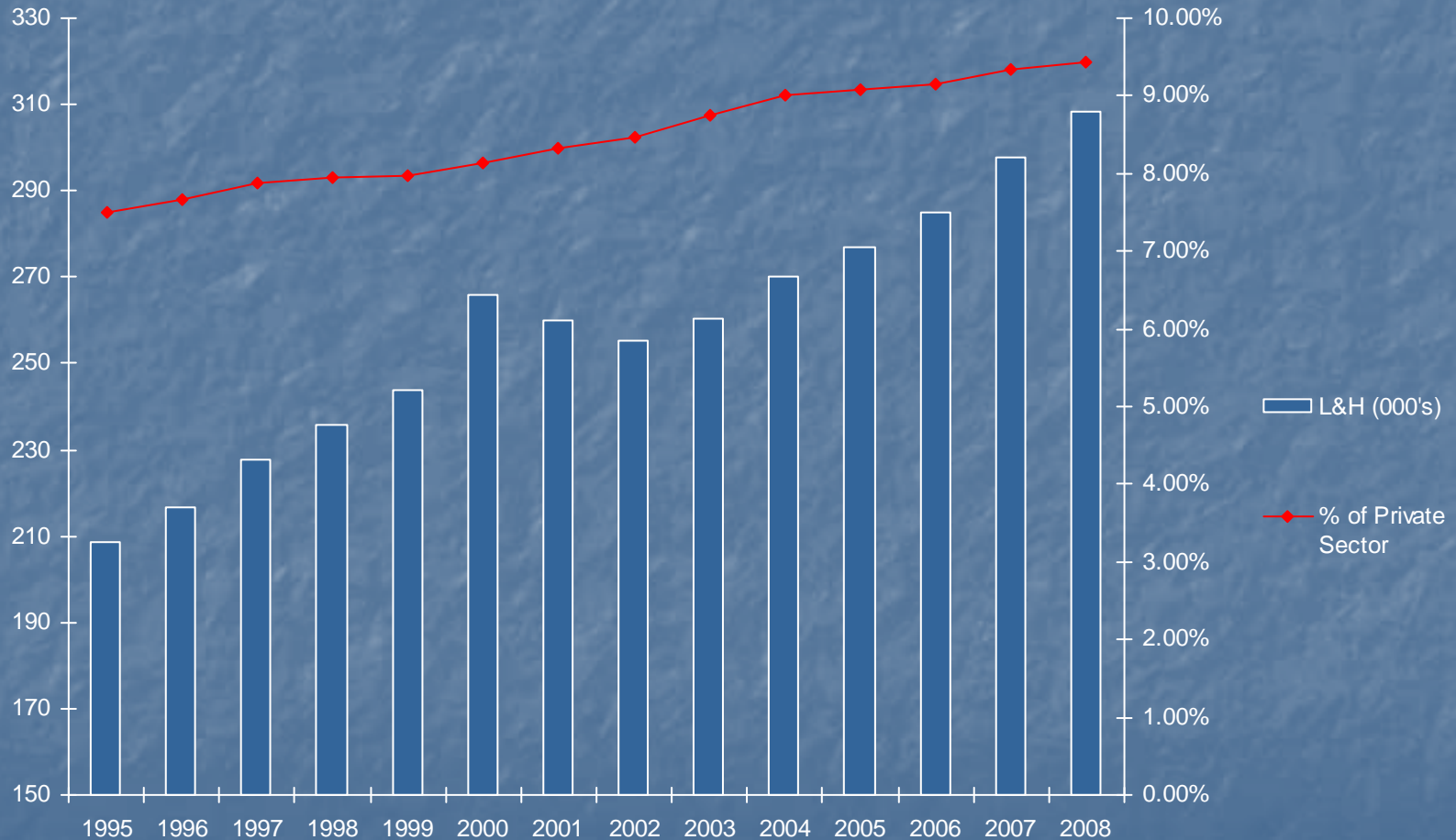
NYC Professional & Business Services Jobs

1995-2008 (In thousands)



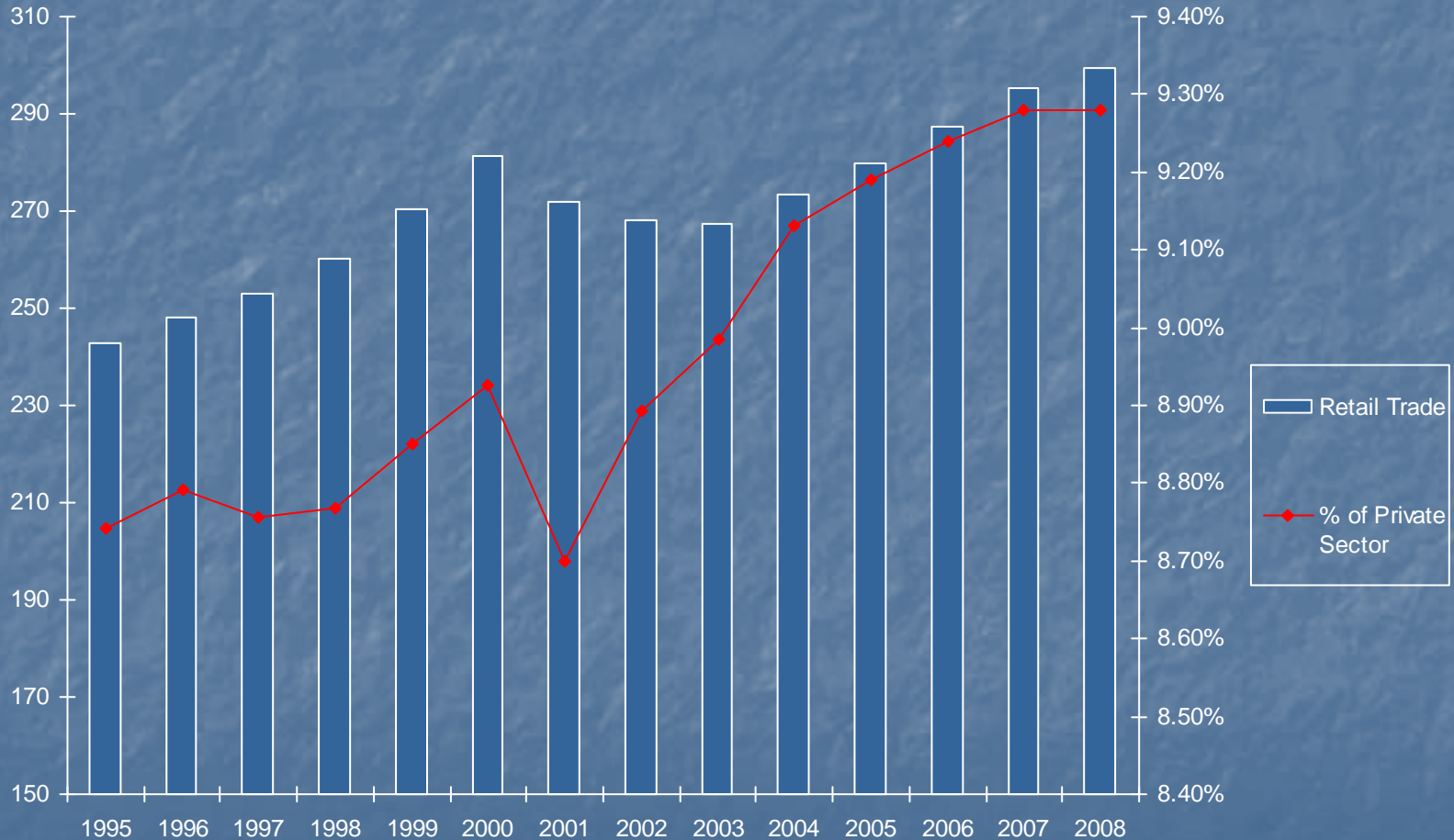
NYC Leisure & Hospitality Jobs

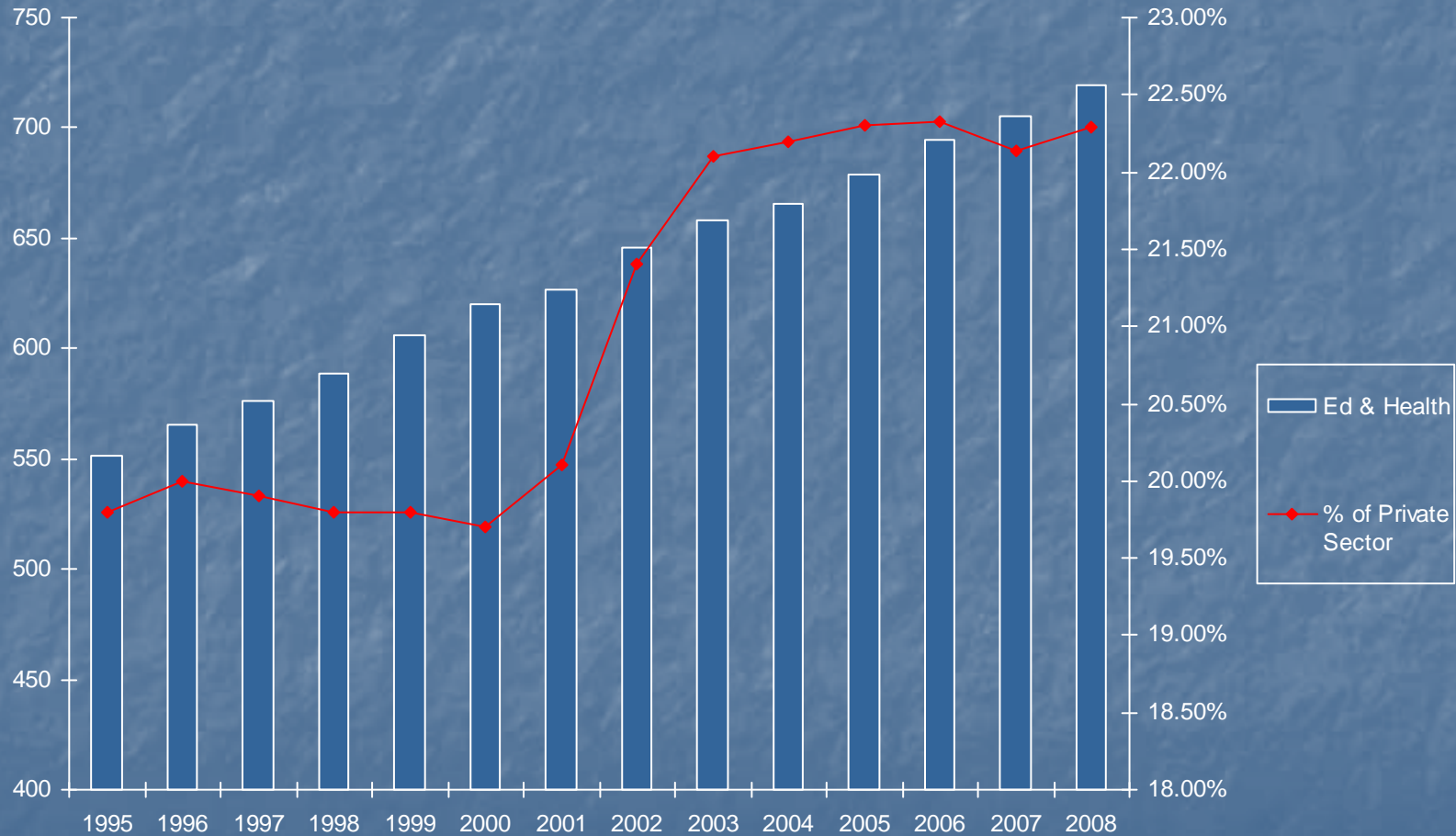
NYC Retail Trade Jobs

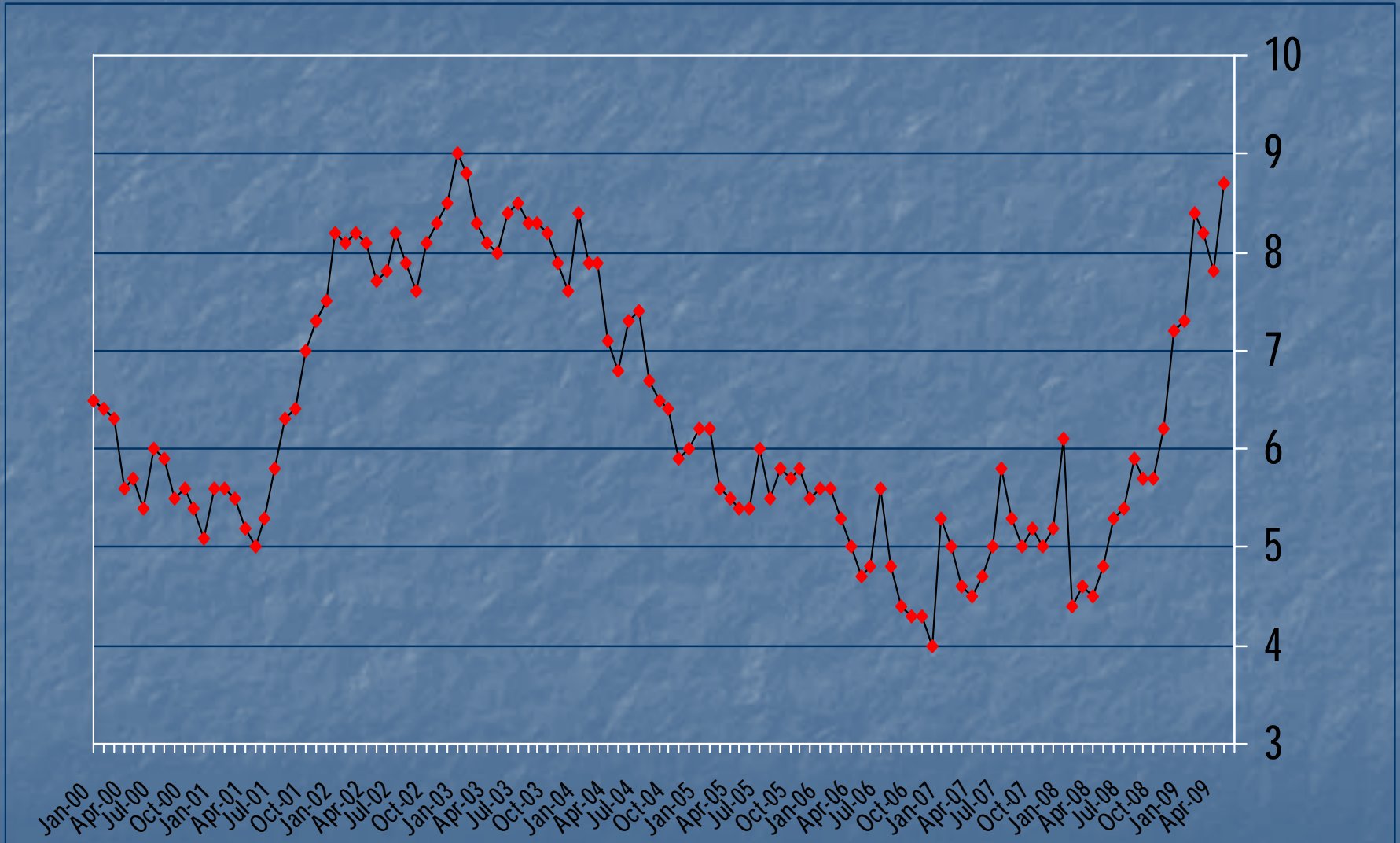


NYC Education & Health Care Jobs

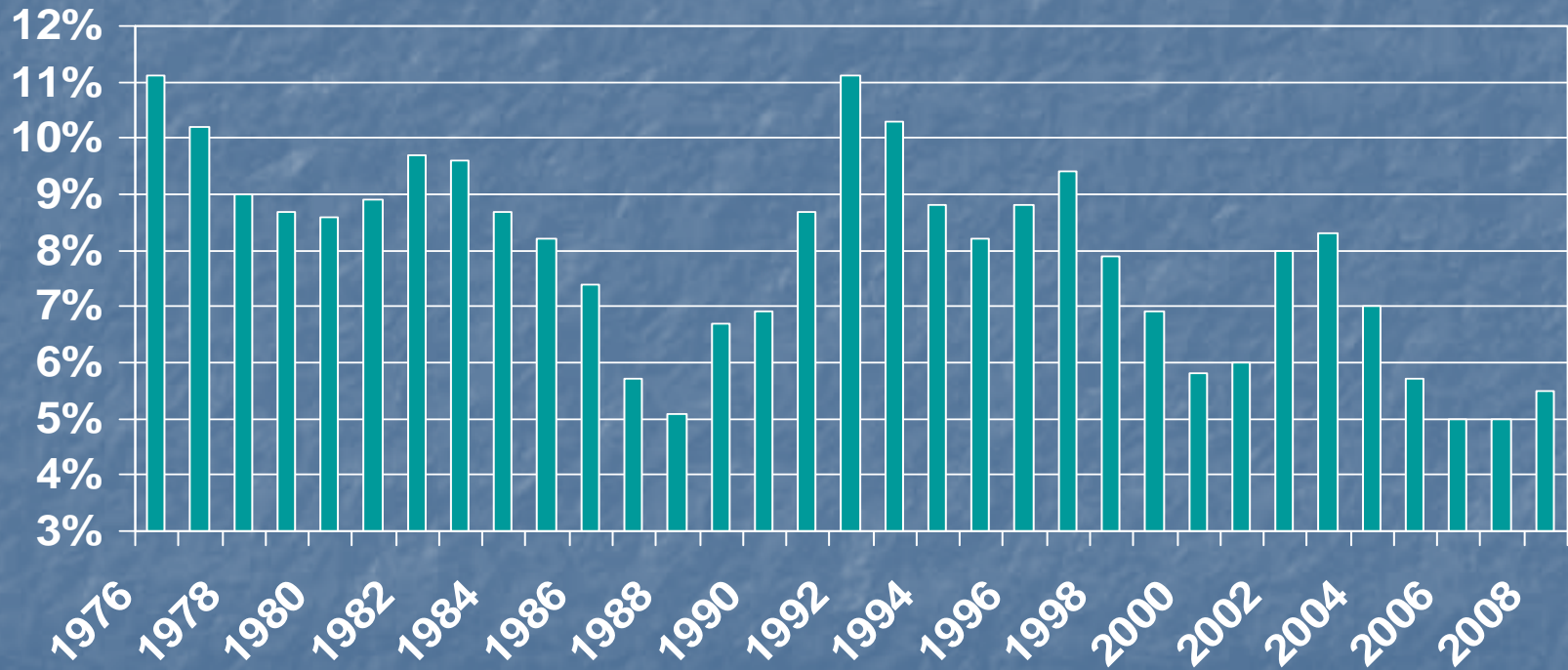


Unemployment Rate in New York City Jan'00-May'09

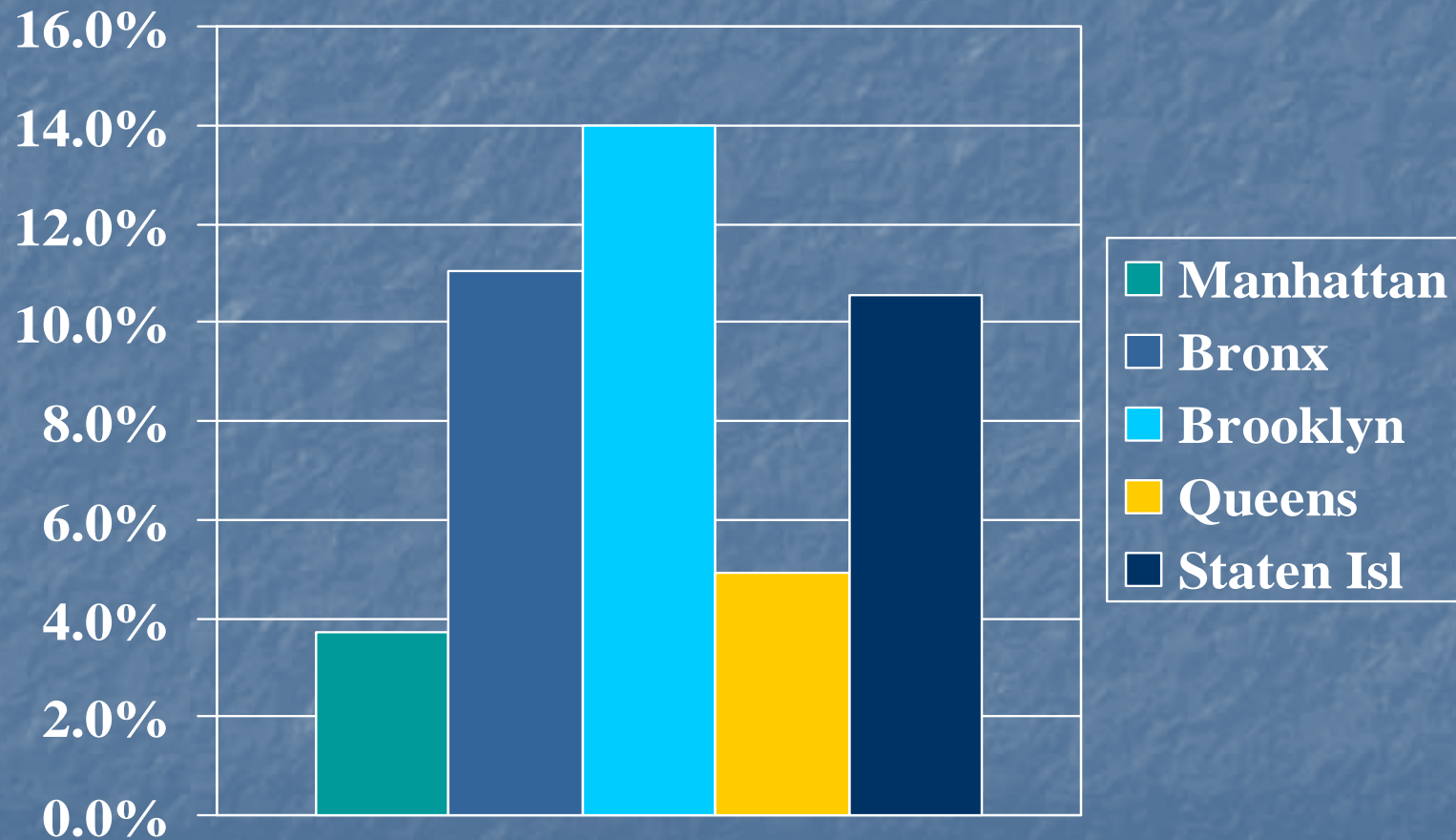


Percent Unemployment

NOTE: This graph refers to jobs located in a borough regardless of where the jobholder lives.

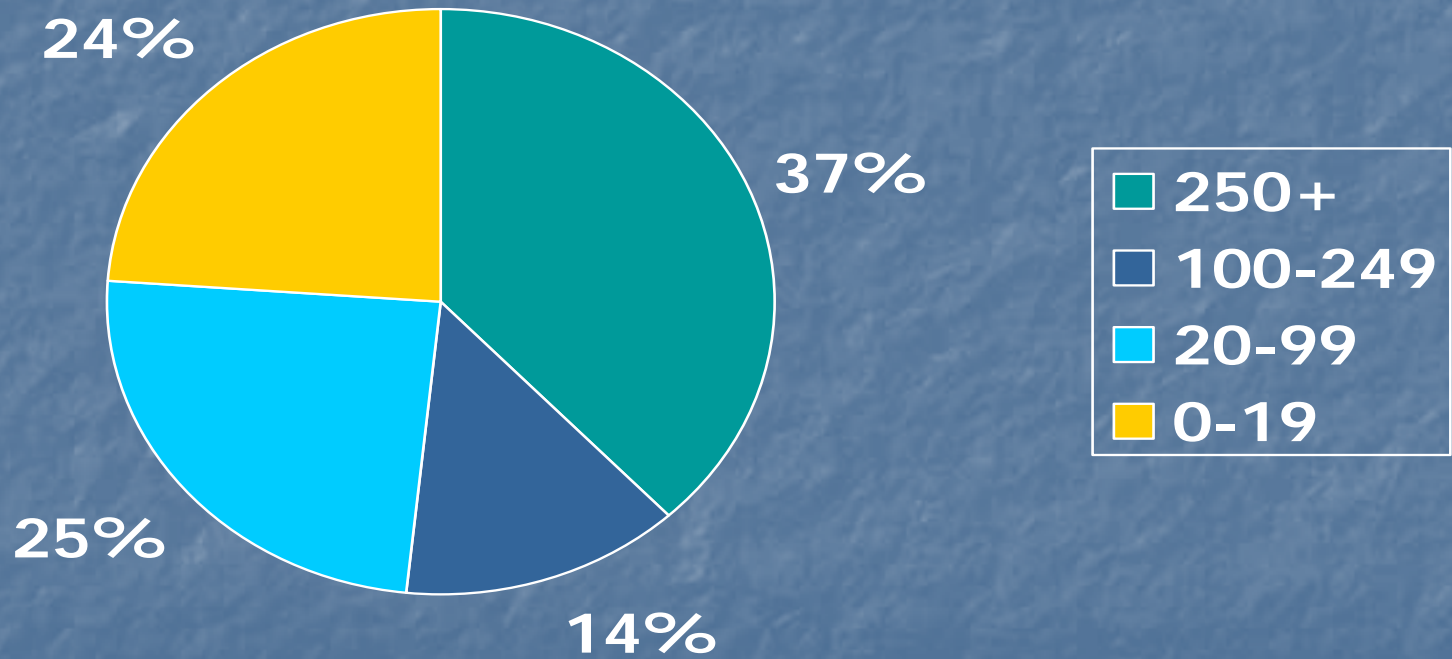
