Dr. Jan Hammond, Associate Professor, is the Coordinator of Interns and Doctoral Joint Program and past chair of the Department of Educational Administration at the State University of New York at New Paltz. Dr. Hammond has held positions of middle and high school teacher, principal and school business administrator as well as college professor. Her educational research expands to most European countries, Japan, Singapore, and India. Dr. Hammond serves on the NYS Department of Education Professional Standards and Practices Board and also the Wallace Leadership General Advisory Council. She is currently the president of the Collegial Association for Developing Educational Administrators (CADEA), a state organization that serves to advance educational administration preparation programs in New York State. She has also held the following positions: President of New York State Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (NYS ASCD), Chair of New York State Association for Women in Administration (NYSAWA), and Coordinator for New York State Association of School Business Officials (NYS ASBO).

Dr. Hammond earned her Bachelor of Arts degree at the State University of New York at Cortland, her Master of Science degree at Western Connecticut State University, and her Certificate of Advanced Study at Southern Connecticut State University. She earned her Doctor of Education degree at Teachers College, Columbia University.
