Mr. Brown has been a Labor Market Analyst for New York City since 1987. In this position he provides economic analysis of the City's job market with an emphasis on labor issues, and also writes periodic articles for state publications which summarize economic trends in New York City. Mr. Brown frequently conducts workshops for college or high school students, displaced workers, welfare recipients and counselors stressing employer requirements and the changing world of work. He also speaks at meetings of business owners and placement professionals concentrating on economic trends, growing industries, demographic trends and the changing nature of work. He is also involved in the preparation of demand lists and occupational projections used by many of the City's training programs and schools.
